3. Any response to this Motion must be filed and delivered not

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
later than September 17, 2004, which is three days before the time set for the hearing (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) or September 13, 2004, which is seven days before the time set for the hearing (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays). **UNLESS A RESPONSE OPPOSING THE MOTION IS TIMELY FILED, THE COURT MAY GRANT THE MOTION WITHOUT A HEARING.**

4. This Court has jurisdiction over this Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§157 and 1334 Fed. R. Bankr. P. 5005 and Local Rule 1070-1. This proceeding is a core proceeding. The petition commencing this Chapter 7 was filed on March 1, 2003. The case is now pending in this Court.

5. This Motion arises under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7055. This Motion is filed under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014 and Local Rule 7055-1. Movant requests entry of a default judgment against the Defendant, Scott Allen Olin who has failed to file an Answer or otherwise appear in this matter, and that the time allowed by law and specified in the Summons for the Defendant to answer has elapsed.



This matter came before the Court upon the Polk County Fair Society, Inc.'s Amended Motion for Entry of Default Judgment in Adversary Proceeding Number 03-4145. Based upon the pleadings, file and record herein, and pursuant to local Bankruptcy Rule 7055-1 and 9021-1, this Court makes the following **FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER FOR JUDGMENT:**

1. Plaintiff, Polk County Fair Society, Inc., is an agency with the State of Wisconsin with an address of 1349 - 85th Avenue, Amery, Wisconsin 54001.
2. Defendant, Scott Allen Olin is a Debtor in the above-captioned Chapter 7 bankruptcy and is formerly the treasurer of the Polk County Fair Society, Inc. and at all times relevant to this action, has been a resident of the State of Minnesota.
3. On or about June 14, 1993, a complaint was filed against the debtor named herein by the State of Wisconsin for a violation of Wis. Stat. §943.20(1)(b), Theft-Business Setting (>\$2500).

4. That said violation alleged that the debtor named herein had embezzled from the Polk County Fair Society, Inc. for which the debtor was serving as a duly elected treasurer.
5. That on or about March 28, 1994, the Court found the debtor named herein guilty of embezzling an amount of \$33,731.62 from the Polk County Fair Society, Inc a class C felony in violation of Wis. Stat. §943.20(1)(b), Theft-Business Setting (>\$2500).
6. That as a condition of the debtor's probation, he was to repay the Polk County Fair Society, Inc. an amount of \$33,731.62 during the course of five (5) years.
7. That on or about May 15, 2002, the State of Wisconsin, by and through the Honorable James R. Erickson, Circuit Judge of Polk County, Wisconsin, did sign a Judgement for Restitution against the debtor named herein for the amount of \$33,731.62.
8. That on or about May 24, 2002, the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Polk County, State of Wisconsin, did docket a Judgment for Money against the debtor named herein.
9. That on March 1, 2003, the defendant filed Chapter 7 Bankruptcy, in the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Minnesota.
10. That on the 7th of April, 2003, a letter was written to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court objecting to the discharge of the defendant's debt to the Polk County Fair Society.
11. That on the 18th of February, 2004, a Summons was issued by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court and provided to me.
12. That on the 23rd of February, 2004, I served said Summons and a Complaint upon the Attorney for Debtor, Becky A. Moshier, by way of Certified Mail, #7002 0510 0000 0336 0476.
13. That on the 23rd of February, 2004, I served said Summons and Complaint upon the Debtor, Scott Allen Olin, by way of Certified Mail, #7002 0510 0000 0336 0452.
14. That on the 23rd of February, 2004, I served said Summons and Complaint upon the Trustee, Habbo Fokkena, by way of Certified Mail, #7002 0510 0000 0336 0469.

15. That at no time did either the defendant or anyone acting on his behalf serve or file and answer to the aforementioned Summons and Complaint.
16. To date, the plaintiff has incurred court fees in the amount of \$150.00.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. This case arose under 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(4). This matter is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §157(b)(2)(1). This Court has jurisdiction over this adversary proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1334.
2. The entire amount of the original indebtedness owed by debtor to the Polk County Fair Society, Inc., represents money, property, and/or credit obtained through fraud or defalcation while acting in a fiduciary capacity, embezzlement, or larceny and is therefore non-dischargeable under §523(a)(4).
3. That pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure §7012, Debtor had 30 days in which to answer the Summons and Complaint of the plaintiff, however, he did not do so. The debt, therefore, is non-dischargeable.
4. Based upon the foregoing, the Debtor's total debt to the Polk County Fair Society, Inc., in the amount of \$33,731.62 is non-dischargeable pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §423(a)(4).

ORDER FOR ENTRY OF JUDGMENT

1. That judgment shall be entered in favor of the Polk County Fair Society, Inc. and against the Debtor in the total amount of \$33,731.62.
2. That the Debtor's debt to the Polk County Fair Society, Inc. in the amount of \$33,731.62 is excepted from discharge pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §523(a)(4)

LET JUDGMENT BE ENTERED ACCORDINGLY.
