**NOTICE OF HEARING AND MOTION
OBJECTING TO CLAIM OF CREDITOR
(CLAIM NO. 12)**

TO: Entities specified in Local Rule 3007-1.

1. Terri A. Georgen-Running, trustee (the "Trustee") of the bankruptcy estate of the above-named Debtor(s) moves the Court for the relief requested below and gives notice of hearing.

2. A hearing will be held on this motion by the Honorable Nancy C. Dreher, Courtroom No. 7 West, 7th Floor - United States Courthouse, 300 S. Fourth Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota on **September 22, 2004** at 10:30 **a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard.

3. Any response to this motion must be filed and delivered not later than September 15, 2004, which is seven (7) days before the hearing date, including intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, or filed and served by mail not later than September 10, 2004, which is ten (10) days before the hearing date, including intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays. **UNLESS A RESPONSE OPPOSING THE MOTION IS TIMELY FILED, THE COURT MAY GRANT THE MOTION WITHOUT A HEARING.**

4. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, FED. R. BANKR. P. 5005 and Local Rule 1070-1. This is a core proceeding. The petition commencing this Chapter 7 case was filed on April 10, 2003 and is now pending before this court.

5. This motion arises under 11 U.S.C. §§502 and 704, FED. R. BANKR. P. 3002 and 3007 and Local Rule 3007-1. This motion is filed under FED. R. BANKR. P. 9014 and 9014 and Local Rule 9013. The Trustee requests relief with respect to Claim No. 12 filed in the Debtor(s)' case.

6. Celine ("Claimant") filed a proof of claim on October 22, 2003, asserting an unsecured non-priority claim in the amount of \$1,469.39 plus interest. The proof of claim indicates that the basis for the claim is for money loaned. The proof of claim indicates that it includes \$33.06 in interest.

7. The trustee is unable to determine whether the interest is pre-petition interest or post-petition interest.

WHEREFORE, the Trustee respectfully requests that the Court disallow Claim No. 12 of Claimant to the extent that it exceeds the principal amount due - \$1,469.39 and such other relief as may be just and equitable.
