Debtors' Response to U.S.Trustee's Request for Dismissal

Debtor, Mike Rysso, as and for his Response to the U.S. Trustee's request for dismissal, provides as follows:

- 1 The U.S. Trustee alleges that debtor has failed to cooperate with the U.S. Trustee's objection. The objection brought by the U.S. Trustee has been brought in bad faith.**
- 2 Debtor's attorney received a request from the U.S. Trustee for documents on September 7, 2004. Those documents were forwarded to the Debtor that same day with an explanation, and debtor is presumed to have received the letter from his attorney by September 10, 2004. See Exhibit A.**
- 3 On September 21, debtor drove 45 miles to his attorneys' office to hand deliver his organized and collated responsive documents to his attorney, and she mailed them to the U.S. Trustee that same day. See Exhibit B.**
- 4 On September 23, 2004, the U.S. Trustee objected to Debtor's Chapter 7 Bankruptcy, claiming that debtor had not responded fast enough to their requests.**
- 5 The U.S. Trustee's objection is absurd. The Debtor did nothing to delay or hinder an investigation, and he provided all requested documents as fast as he could obtain them. The Debtor responded in 11 days.**
- 6 Debtor asks that the U.S. Trustees motion be dismissed.**
