**NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION TO  
DISMISS CHAPTER 7 PROCEEDING**

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TO All Creditors and interested parties:

I.

Patti J. Sullivan, Trustee of the Captioned Chapter 7 proceeding moves the court for the relief requested below and gives notice of hearing herewith. On October 5, 2004 at 10:30A.M., in Courtroom No. 228B, at the United States Court House, 316 N Robert St., St. Paul, Minnesota 55101, the Court will hold a hearing to determine whether this case should be dismissed. The hearing may be continued by notice at the hearing without further written notice. Any response, answer or objection to the Motion with or without affidavits must be filed and delivered not later than 10:30A.M. on September 30, 2004, which is three days before the time set for the hearing (excluding intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays), or filed and served by mail not later than September 24, 2004, which is seven days before the time set for hearing (excluding intermediate Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays). Local Bankruptcy Rule 9006-1. **UNLESS A RESPONSE OPPOSING THE MOTION IS TIMELY FILED, THE COURT MAY GRANT THE MOTION WITHOUT A HEARING.**

II.

This Court has jurisdiction over this Motion and this Motion is authorized under 28 U.S.C. Sections 157 and 1334, Bankruptcy Rule 5005, and Local Bankruptcy Rule 1070-1. This

proceeding arises under 11 U.S.C. Section 343, and Trustee requests that the Court dismiss this Chapter 7 proceeding.

### III.

Debtors filed their petition for relief under Chapter 7 of the United States Bankruptcy Code on July 1, 2004, and the case is now pending in this Court. Patti J. Sullivan was appointed Trustee of the Chapter 7 case, and she is authorized to commence this proceeding. To the best of Trustee's knowledge, the debtors have not yet been granted a discharge of their debts.

### IV.

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 343 and Bankruptcy Rule 2003(a), the first meeting of creditors was originally scheduled for July 27, 2004. The debtors failed to appear at the first meeting of creditors. The first meeting was then rescheduled to August 27, 2004 at which time debtors again failed to appear. As a result, the debtors have not submitted to examination at a first meeting of creditors as required by 11 U.S. C. §343.

### V.

Debtors' failure to appear and submit to examination under oath at the first meeting of creditors makes it impossible for the Trustee to administer the Chapter 7 estate and constitutes grounds for dismissal of the Chapter 7 proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Trustee prays for an order of this Court dismissing this Chapter 7 proceeding and granting such other and further relief as the Court deems just and equitable.
