NOTICE OF HEARING AND MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY

TO: Debtor and other entities specified in Local Rule 9013-3(a).

1. ABN AMRO Mortgage Group, Inc. (hereinafter "Secured Creditor"), by its undersigned attorney moves the Court for the relief requested below and gives notice of hearing herewith.

2. The Court will hold a hearing on this motion on October 4, 2004, at 10:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, before the Honorable Gregory F. Kishel in Courtroom 228B of the above entitled Court located at U.S. Courthouse, 316 North Robert Street, St. Paul, Minnesota.

3. Any response to this motion must be filed and delivered not later than September 29, 2004, which is three days before the time set for the hearing (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays), or served and filed by mail not later than September 23, 2004, which is seven days before the time set for the hearing (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays). **UNLESS A RESPONSE OPPOSING THE MOTION IS TIMELY FILED, THE COURT MAY GRANT THE MOTION WITHOUT A HEARING.**

4. This Court has jurisdiction over this motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 5005 and Local Rule 1070-1. This proceeding is a core proceeding. The petition commencing this case was filed on July 28, 2004. The case is now pending in this Court.

5. This motion arises under 11 U.S.C. § 362 and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 4001.

This motion is filed under Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9014 and Local Rules 9013-1 - 9019-1. Movant requests relief from the automatic stay with respect to property subject to a lien. Movant requests said relief be effective immediately notwithstanding Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 4001(a)(3).

6. Debtor is indebted to Secured Creditor in the original principal amount of \$88,000.00, as evidenced by that certain Promissory Note dated April 11, 2003, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", together with interest thereon.

7. Debtor's indebtedness is secured by a mortgage on real estate in which Debtor has an interest as evidenced by that certain mortgage deed dated April 11, 2003, executed by Curt D. Koestler and Kristin Koestler, husband and wife as joint tenants, recorded on April 23, 2004, as Document No. 428349, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B". The name and address of the original creditor is contained in the attached Exhibit "B". The property is located in Morrison County, Minnesota and is legally described as follows to-wit:

Real property in Morrison County, Minnesota, described as follows: South 40 feet of Lot Seven (7), Block Forty-four (44), Original Plat of the Town (now City) of Little Falls, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the County Recorder in and for Morrison County, Minnesota. Being the same property conveyed to Curt D. Koestler and Kristin Koestler, husband and wife, as joint tenants, by Warranty Deed dated June 16, 1999, of record in Document No. 391072, in the Office of the Recorder of Morrison County, Minnesota

Secured Creditor is now the holder of said mortgage and is entitled to enforce the terms thereof.

8. At all times material, Debtor was in default of the payments and performance of obligations to Secured Creditor.

9. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(g) the burden is on Debtor to prove absence of cause and/or adequate protection. This secured creditor's interest in the property is not adequately protected where, as of September 20, 2004, Debtor is delinquent in the making of monthly payments as required for the months of April, 2004 through September, 2004, inclusive, in the amount of \$731.00 each; accruing late charges of \$184.62 and attorneys fees and costs of \$700.00. Debtor has failed to make any offer of adequate protection.

According to the Debtor's Chapter 13 Plan they intend to surrender the property.

10. Debtor has no equity in the property and the property is not necessary to an effective reorganization. The value of the property as scheduled by Debtor is \$88,000.00 subject to Secured Creditor's mortgage in excess of \$91,755.86.

The burden is on Debtor to establish that this property is necessary to an effective reorganization.

11. Secured Creditor desires to protect its interest in the aforementioned property and requests the Court to vacate the stay of actions and allow foreclosure pursuant to Minnesota law.

12. Secured Creditor has incurred and will incur legal fees and costs to protect and enforce its rights in the subject property.

WHEREFORE, Secured Creditor, by its undersigned attorney, moves the Court for an order for judgment that the automatic stay provided by 11 U.S.C. § 362(a) be modified so to permit the movant to commence mortgage foreclosure proceedings under Minnesota law and for such other relief as may be just and equitable.

1. BORROWER'S PROMISE TO PAY

In return for a loan that I have received, I promise to pay U.S. \$88,000.00 (this amount is called "Principal"), plus interest, to the order of the Lender. The Lender is First Residential Mortgage Network, Inc., DBA First Residential Network, Inc.

I will make all payments under this Note in the form of cash, check or money order.

I understand that the Lender may transfer this Note. The Lender or anyone who takes this Note by transfer and who is entitled to receive payments under this Note is called the "Note Holder."

2. INTEREST

Interest will be charged on unpaid principal until the full amount of Principal has been paid. I will pay interest at a yearly rate of 7.500%.

The interest rate required by this Section 2 is the rate I will pay both before and after any default described in Section 6(B) of this Note.

3. PAYMENTS**(A) Time and Place of Payments**

I will pay principal and interest by making a payment every month.

I will make my monthly payment on the 1st day of each month beginning on June 1, 2003. I will make these payments every month until I have paid all of the principal and interest and any other charges described below that I may owe under this Note. Each monthly payment will be applied as of its scheduled due date and will be applied to interest before Principal. If, on May 1, 2033, I still owe amounts under this Note, I will pay those amounts in full on that date, which is called the "Maturity Date."

(B) Amount of Monthly Payments

My monthly payment will be in the amount of U.S. \$615.31.

4. BORROWER'S RIGHT TO PREPAY

I have the right to make payments of Principal at any time before they are due. A payment of Principal only is known as a "Prepayment." When I make a Prepayment, I will tell the Note Holder in writing that I am doing so. I may not designate a payment as a Prepayment if I have not made all the monthly payments due under the Note.

I may make a full Prepayment or partial Prepayments without paying a Prepayment charge. The Note Holder will use my Prepayments to reduce the amount of Principal that I owe under this Note. However, the Note Holder may apply my Prepayment to the accrued and unpaid interest on the Prepayment amount, before applying my Prepayment to reduce the Principal amount of the Note. If I make a partial Prepayment, there will be no changes in the due date or in the amount of my monthly payment unless the Note Holder agrees in writing to those changes.

5. LOAN CHARGES

If a law, which applies to this loan and which sets maximum loan charges, is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with this loan exceed the permitted limits, then: (a) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limit; and (b) any sums already collected from me which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to me. The Note Holder may choose to make this refund by reducing the Principal I owe under this Note or by making a direct payment to me. If a refund reduces Principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial Prepayment.

6. BORROWER'S FAILURE TO PAY AS REQUIRED**(A) Late Charge for Overdue Payments**

If the Note Holder has not received the full amount of any monthly payment by the end of FIFTEEN calendar days after the date it is due, I will pay a late charge to the Note Holder. The amount of the charge will be 5.000% of my overdue payment of principal and interest. I will pay this late charge promptly but only once on each late payment.

(B) Default

If I do not pay the full amount of each monthly payment on the date it is due, I will be in default.

(C) Notice of Default

If I am in default, the Note Holder may send me a written notice telling me that if I do not pay the overdue amount by a certain date, the Note Holder may require me to pay immediately the full amount of Principal which has not been paid and all the interest that I owe on that amount. That date must be at least 30 days after the date on which the notice is mailed to me or delivered by other means.

(D) No Waiver by Note Holder

Even if, at a time when I am in default, the Note Holder does not require me to pay immediately in full as described above, the Note Holder will still have the right to do so if I am in default at a later time.

- (H) "Applicable Law" means all controlling applicable federal, state and local statutes, regulations, ordinances and administrative rules and orders (that have the effect of law) as well as all applicable final, non-appealable judicial opinions.

(I) "Community Association Dues, Fees, and Assessments" means all dues, fees, assessments and other charges that are imposed on Borrower or the Property by a condominium association, homeowners association or similar organization.

(J) "Electronic Funds Transfer" means any transfer of funds, other than a transaction originated by check, draft, or similar paper instrument, which is initiated through an electronic terminal, telephonic instrument, computer, or magnetic tape so as to order, instruct, or authorize a financial institution to debit or credit an account. Such term includes, but is not limited to, point-of-sale transfers, automated teller machine transactions, transfers initiated by telephone, wire transfers, and automated clearinghouse transfers.

(K) "Escrow Items" means those items that are described in Section 3.

(L) "Miscellaneous Proceeds" means any compensation, settlement, award of damages, or proceeds paid by any third party (other than insurance proceeds paid under the coverages described in Section 5) for: (i) damage to, or destruction of, the Property; (ii) condemnation or other taking of all or any part of the Property; (iii) conveyance in lieu of condemnation; or (iv) misrepresentations of, or omissions as to, the value and/or condition of the Property.

(M) "Mortgage Insurance" means insurance protecting Lender against the nonpayment of, or default on, the Loan.

(N) "Periodic Payment" means the regularly scheduled amount due for (i) principal and interest under the Note, plus (ii) any amounts under Section 3 of this Security Instrument.

Payments are deemed received by Lender when received at the location designated in the Note or at such other location as may be designated by Lender in accordance with the notice provisions in Section 15. Lender may return any payment or partial payment if the payment or partial payments are insufficient to bring the Loan current. Lender may accept any payment or partial payment insufficient to bring the Loan current, without waiver of any rights hereunder or prejudice to its rights to refuse such payment or partial payments in the future, but Lender is not obligated to apply such payments at the time such payments are accepted. If each Periodic Payment is applied as makes payment to bring the Loan current, then Lender need not pay interest on unapplied funds. 

**MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY**

ARGUMENT

I. CAUSE EXISTS FOR THE GRANTING OF RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1) WHERE THE INTEREST OF THIS SECURED CREDITOR IS NOT ADEQUATELY PROTECTED.

Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(g) the burden is on Debtor to prove absence of cause and/or adequate protection. Secured Creditor's interest in the property is not adequately protected where:

1. As of September 20, 2004, Debtor is delinquent for monthly payments as required for the months of April, 2004 through September, 2004, in the amount of \$731.00 each; accruing late charges of \$184.62 and attorneys fees and costs of \$700.00.

2. Debtor has failed to make any offer of adequate protection. According to the Debtor's Chapter 13 Plan they intend to surrender the property.

Furthermore, Debtor has failed to meet its contractual obligations to make payments as they become due after the filing of the bankruptcy petition, which failure constitutes "cause" entitling the Secured Creditor to relief from the automatic stay under 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1). A continued failure by Debtor to maintain regular payments to Secured Creditor is sufficient cause to entitle Secured Creditor to relief from the automatic stay. See In re Taylor, 151 B.R. 646 (E.D.N.Y., 1993) and In re Davis, 64 B.R. 358 (Bkrtcy.

S.D.N.Y., 1986).

II. THE AUTOMATIC STAY SHOULD BE MODIFIED PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(2) WHERE (1) DEBTOR DOES NOT HAVE ANY EQUITY IN THE PROPERTY, AND (2) THE PROPERTY IS NOT NECESSARY TO AN EFFECTIVE REORGANIZATION.

The first requirement under § 362(d)(2) is met where the total of all the encumbrances against the property is in excess of the value of the property. The value of the property as scheduled by Debtor is \$88,000.00 subject to Secured Creditor's mortgage in excess of \$91,755.86.

The burden is on Debtor to establish that this property is necessary to an effective reorganization.

CONCLUSION

Secured Creditor is entitled to relief from the automatic stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(1) for cause, and where its interest in the secured property is not adequately protected. Secured Creditor is also entitled to relief from the automatic stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d)(2) where Debtor has no equity in the property, and where the property is not necessary to an effective reorganization.

Secured Creditor respectfully requests an order of this Court modifying the automatic stay consistent with the attached proposed Order.


