other basis for such objection. The objections shall not include legal argument. The objections

shall not include citation to case law authority. Presentation of legal argument in support of or in

opposition to any confirmation objection is reserved until further order of this court.

2. No responses or replies to any objection shall be permitted until further order of

this court.

3. A scheduling conference regarding the above-captioned bankruptcy case will be held in Courtroom 8 West, United States Courthouse, 300 South Fourth Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, on <u>June 15, 2017 at 9:30 a.m.</u>, at which time the court and the parties will determine a briefing schedule to further address all plan confirmation objections.

4. No party shall retain any expert until further order.

5. No party shall conduct any discovery until further order.
