SCHEDULING ORDER

The case is before the court on the motion of the debtor for a status and scheduling conference.

Based on the motion and file,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. In accordance with Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 2002(b) and 9006(c)(1), objections to confirmation of either the debtor's proposed plan of reorganization or the committee of unsecured creditors' proposed plan of reorganization must be served in accordance with Local Rule 3020-1(b) and filed by no later than **June 7, 2017**. Any such objection shall consist solely of a list of every basis upon which the objecting party objects to confirmation of a plan. The recitation of each individual objection listed by a party within the filing is limited to 200 words, including the title of that particular objection and the statutory or other basis for such objection. The objections shall not include legal argument. The objections shall not include citation to case law authority. Presentation of legal argument in support of or in opposition to any confirmation objection is reserved until further order of this court.

2. No responses or replies to any objection shall be permitted until further order of this court.

3. A scheduling conference regarding the above-captioned bankruptcy case will be held in Courtroom 8 West, United States Courthouse, 300 South Fourth Street, Minneapolis, Minnesota, on **June 15, 2017 at 9:30 a.m.**, at which time the court and the parties will determine a briefing schedule to further address all plan confirmation objections.

4. No party shall retain any expert until further order.

5. No party shall conduct any discovery until further order.
