

Certain fees to increase effective December 1, 2016

In September 2016, the Judicial Conference approved inflationary adjustments to certain fees on the bankruptcy court miscellaneous fee schedule. These changes will take effect December 1, 2016.

The fees affected are as follows:

Bankruptcy Court Miscellaneous Fee Schedule (28 U.S.C. § 1930)
