



The following are the reasons a refund may be allowed. All other requests will be made by motion utilizing the Motion for Refund of Payment to Court event. Information on filing a motion can be found [here](#).

1. Duplicate payment.
2. Trustee deposits made from the wrong account.

Request for Refund of Pay.gov Payment Made in Error

Before docketing request for refund, you will need the amount, receipt number, date of payment and name of Payor.

1. CM/ECF > Bankruptcy	
2. Post-Petition Events > Other Case Events	

<p>3. Enter Case Number.</p> <p>Click Next.</p>	
<p>4. Select event “Request for Refund of Pay.gov Payment Made in Error”</p> <p>Click Next.</p>	
<p>5. Select the party requesting refund.</p> <p>Click Next.</p>	
<p>6. Complete all textboxes.</p> <p>Click Next.</p>	

<p>7. Select one of the three options.
