## AMENDMENTS TO LOCAL RULES AND LOCAL FORMS EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2024

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Minnesota is amending several local rules in the 5000, 6000, and 7000 series and is abrogating three Local Forms. The amendments also include two new forms to be maintained by the Clerk of Court: Registry Deposit Information Form and Registry Withdrawal Payee Information Form.

On December 21, 2023, the Court issued for public comment proposed amendments to these Local Rules and Local Forms. After considering the public comments that were received and the recommendations of the Bankruptcy Practice Committee, chaired by attorney Nicole Anderson, the Court now issues amendments to these Local Rules and Local Forms, effective Wednesday, September 4, 2024.

The purpose of the amendments is to conform the Local Rules and Local Forms with the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and current practice. These amendments are the second set of a larger project to substantively review all Local Rules.
